Read and Publish license agreements

The Society actively encourages open access in scholarly communication. Our Read and Publish license helps to increase your institution's research exposure and allows authors to publish more content in an open access format, leading to wider dissemination and increased potential for downloads and citations.



The **Lyell Collection Complete online licence agreement** includes read access to 18 sites which comprises 7 actively publishing hybrid journals, one fully open access journal (Earth Science, Systems and Society (ES³)), one fully open access book series (GeoHorizons), 4 active hybrid book series (Special Publications, Engineering Geology Special Publications, Memoirs, and the Energy Geoscience Conference Series) and 5 historic content sites.

The agreement also covers unlimited open access publishing of all article types in the hybrid and fully open access journals and the hybrid and fully open access book series. Authors at institutions who sign up will be able to take advantage of streamlined Open Access publishing where fees have already been included in the agreement with their institution.

The eligible author must be the corresponding author and submit using their institutional affiliation and matching email address. Agreements for 2025 apply to articles with a 2025 submission date.

In December 2023 we partnered with ChronosHub for open access article processing. ChronosHub streamlines the workflow for institutions for effective APC management and reporting.

Continuous Publication Model

Under the continuous publication model, as soon as an article is ready to be published, it will be immediately assigned to a journal issue online rather than waiting for other articles in the issue to be completed, resulting in faster access to the final version of the article.

Article stages:

- “Issue in Progress” applies to journal articles and “Volume in Progress” to book articles.
- **Accepted manuscripts** are posted online within 2 weeks of acceptance to facilitate early access to research and citation for authors and researchers. Digital article identifiers (DOIs) are published for accepted manuscripts and registered with CrossRef allowing permanent resolution to the final version of record when it is published.
- **The version of record** is the typeset article that appears online before the final volume or issue is complete. These articles are in their final PDF format apart from final volume pagination, i.e., they have been accepted for publication, copyedited, typeset, proofed, and corrected.
- **The final version** includes final pagination when the issue/volume is completed.

Subscribers to individual journals can view the full text of all articles and accepted manuscripts in the relevant journal.

Online Archives: *Special Publications*

Geological Society of London Special Publications are renowned throughout the global geoscience community for their high quality of science and production. Each volume focuses on a specific theme and represents a balanced, state-of-the-art treatment of the subject matter. The first was published in 1964 as a supplement to the *Quarterly Journal of the Geological Society* (the precursor to the *Journal of the Geological Society*) and was retrospectively numbered as a Special Publication. The series gained its current clear identity in 1981.

Special Publications form a major part of the Lyell Collection, the Geological Society's online collection of all key content published since 1845. The Collection features Special Publications from Volume 1. Abstracts, PDFs and references have been captured up to and including volume 277, with later volumes also including full text HTML. The Collection benefits from full electronic functionality, including active reference linking.

Purchase Special Publication archives of volumes 1 to 500 outright for a one-off fee allowing perpetual access. Online Archives: *Journal of the Geological Society*

Journal of the Geological Society (JGS) publishes topical, high-quality recent research across the full range of Earth Sciences. Papers are interdisciplinary in nature and emphasize the development of an understanding of fundamental geological processes. The journal includes broad interest articles that refer to regional studies, but which extend beyond their geographical context.

The JGS Archive (1845-2007) includes over 17,000 articles and comprises over 150 years of geoscience research, including historically important content from many eminent scientists. Access the very earliest geological research from the greats such as Darwin, Murchison, and Buckland to modern cutting-edge research from an international field of authors.

The *Quarterly Journal of the Geological Society* (1845 to 1970) was re-named the *Journal of the Geological Society* in 1971.

All JGS volumes are available online on payment of an annual subscription fee (for Journal of the Geological Society alone, or as part of Lyell Collection Complete). Perpetual access applies to content published in the subscribed to years.

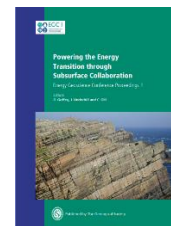

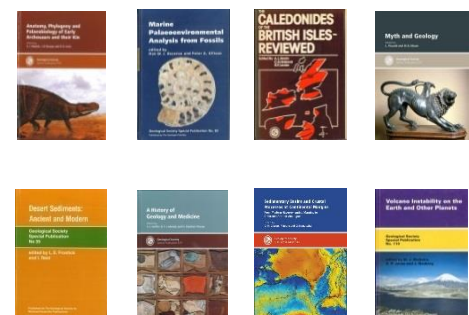
